About SMBC:

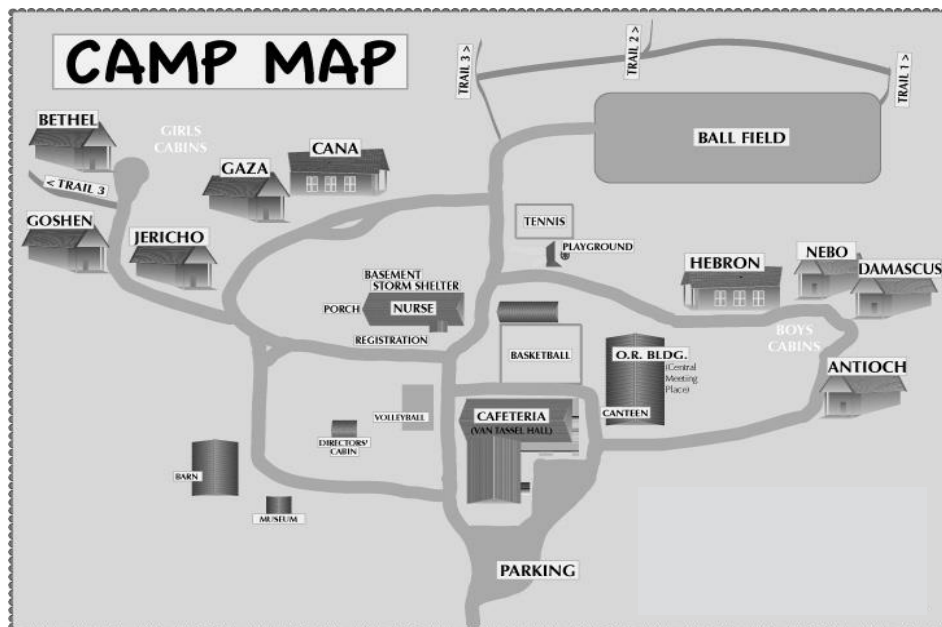
Spring Mill Bible Camp is a ministry of the churches of Christ in Indiana and Kentucky.

Since the first camp session in 1963, thousands of people have grown closer to Jesus and other Christians at SMBC.

SMBC is a non-profit organization operated by a board of directors selected from congregations of churches of Christ and strive together to serve God in the ministry of SMBC.

Location & Facilities:

Located in Lawrence County, 4 miles east of Mitchell, IN, SMBC sits on 75 acres of rolling wooded hills in the heart of southern Indiana. Our facilities consist of 5 Girls Cabins and 4 Boys Cabins with bathrooms & showers in each. The second floor of our cafeteria contains bedrooms, bathrooms, and showers for around 20 staff members. The modern Nurses Cabin has the necessary amenities along with a large pavilion area and a storm shelter basement. Our large parking lot can accommodate 8 RV's with water & electric connections. The O.R. Shelter/Building is our central meeting place with includes a baptistry along with the SMBC Canteen. There is also a large basketball court, tennis courts, ball field and hiking trails.



Camp Rental:

SMBC is available for rent to our brotherhood for retreats, meetings, work shops, family reunions, etc. and can accommodate 150 people total during warm months. For colder months, the Cafeteria, Nurses Cabin, one Boys cabin and one Girls cabin are heated, for a winter capacity of around 50 people.
